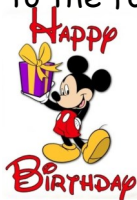

Contacting School



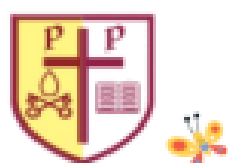
