I will be sending out a letter on the last day to wish you all a pleasant summer and give any final updates.





I am pleased to inform you that following the outstanding success of the previous 30 years coaching courses, we are organising the 2023 Summer Soccer Fun Week.

The children will be coached by F.A. COACHES and EX-PROFESSIONAL PLAYERS. Coaches are DBS checked and safeguarding trained. The coaches will develop self-confidence and self esteem through encouragement and positive reinforcements. SOCCER IS NOT JUST FOR THE STAR PLAYERS!


