MESSAGE FROM HEADTEACHER

Dear Parents/ Carers,

On a Friday all parents whose children have fallen below 90% will receive a text message. This is to inform you that your child has slipped into a % that could be categorised as persistently absent from school and warrant support from social services. Children should be in school and expected attendance is 95%. Thank you for your support with this matter.

This week we are hosting INSPIRE workshop sessions for parents of children in year groups 1-6. Each class teacher will text to remind you of your session date and time—this was listed in last week's letter from me.

We are resuming our Friday assemblies and the children nominated by staff for their outstanding work or behaviour will be mentioned in our weekly newsletter.

We are currently reviewing our safeguarding and behaviour policies. When completed they will be sent to all parents for your information.

Our afterschool clubs are re-starting this week and if your child has gained a place you will have been notified. Children will need to bring kit in on these days to change into unless they already have PE that day.



We are pleased to confirm that our Open Evening for admission to Year 7 in 2024 will take place on Wednesday 27th September 5.30pm - 7.30pm.

We are also opening the school to visitors from 5.30pm -7.30pm. Visitors will be able to walk around key areas of the school site, meet departments and talk to current students and staff.

Entry to the presentation in the hall is by ticket only to ensure that we have seats for everyone. You can book a timed entry via the link on our website one week before the event via www.keslichfield.org.uk. There will be presentations at 5.30pm, 6.30pm and 7.15pm. If you do not attend one of the presentations then you are still free to visit the school between 5.30 and 7.30pm. Senior staff will also be available to answer questions and there will be plenty of informal opportunities to speak to staff and students.
