#### MESSAGE FROM HEADTEACHER

Dear Parents/ Carers,

We have our family Mass this weekend for those children making their First Holy Communion. This is at 11am at SS Peter and Paul church. Families are welcome to join us for this Mass. Please keep those children preparing for their First Holy Communion in your prayers.

The children in Y4,5 and 6 are currently looking at space in various topics and they were able to watch a live stream on Thursday about a rocket take off. The children are really enjoying their Space themed work.

Last week I sent out a newsletter in relation to the family of schools we are currently working with towards academisation. Please do take the time to read through the newsletter. We look forward to be able to share more with you as the project evolves.

Can I remind all parents and carers that the school gates open at 8:45am, they close at 8:55am to children in Reception class upwards. Children arriving after this time will need to come through the front entrance and be signed in by a parent or carer. Collection is at 3:15 from the playground. Reception class pupils are collected from the nursery door, and Y1/2 from their side door.

I was late in sending out attendance texts last week—you will receive a text if your child's attendance falls below 90%. This will help you to track attendance weekly rather than waiting for a half termly letter. Attendance should aim to be 95% or above for all children.

Inspire sessions are spread from the 1st—9th February. Specific dates will be shared in next weeks newsletter.

The weather is set to warm slightly next week, but on these cold days please ensure your child has layers to keep them warm. This helps especially with outdoor PE sessions.

We currently have supply staff in the kitchen as our cook is still unwell. We hope this will be rectified soon. This has unfortunately led to some menu changes over the last few weeks. We will continue to update you of any changes made. And apologise for any confusion caused.


# Interactive Whiteboards SS Peter & Paul Catholic Primary
