School Mission Statement

With Jesus as our guide, we learn, pray and live together in a safe and happy way.

Dear Parent/ Carer,

Well done to all our Y3 children who made their First Holy Communion, they had their thanksgiving Mass last week and received their certificates.

Children are allowed to bring a snack into school to have at morning break. Ks1 children are provided with fruit everyday. Only healthy snacks are allowed to be consumed—these are fruit, string cheese, yoghurt tube, non—chocolate cereal bars or fruit flakes/ bars. This is whole school policy — items such as crisps or sweets will be taken from the children and they can eat these at lunch time with their lunch.

Attendance is still an ongoing issue and we have a number of children whose attendance is still below 90%. Next week I will start to send out regular messages to parents whose children fall below 90%. It is important that children are in school everyday. Holidays cannot be authorised unless there are exceptional circumstances and fines are currently at £60 per child, per adult.

Our Y6 thoroughly enjoyed their trip to Standon Bowers last week, with activities such as climbing, BMXing, scrambling and caving to keep them busy. They were very well behaved and a credit to our school. Photographs of the trip are on the Y6 class page on the website.

We have sent out details of the leavers disco in July. As part of the preparation for this, we are having an own clothes day on Friday — if the children could donate a bag of sweets that could then be sold at the disco. They need to be small bags of sweets in a multipack or a small bag of sweets in an individually wrapped bag. No lollies please.

Can I please remind parents of the importance of children wearing uniform on the days they do not have PE. Children can currently wear summer uniform which is a red check dress or tailored shorts, with a white polo or shirt and a school coloured jumper or cardigan. Trainers should NOT be worn on non- PE days.

We break up for the may half term on Friday and we wish all our families a restful and enjoyable week. We look forward to welcoming children back to school on the 5th June.


