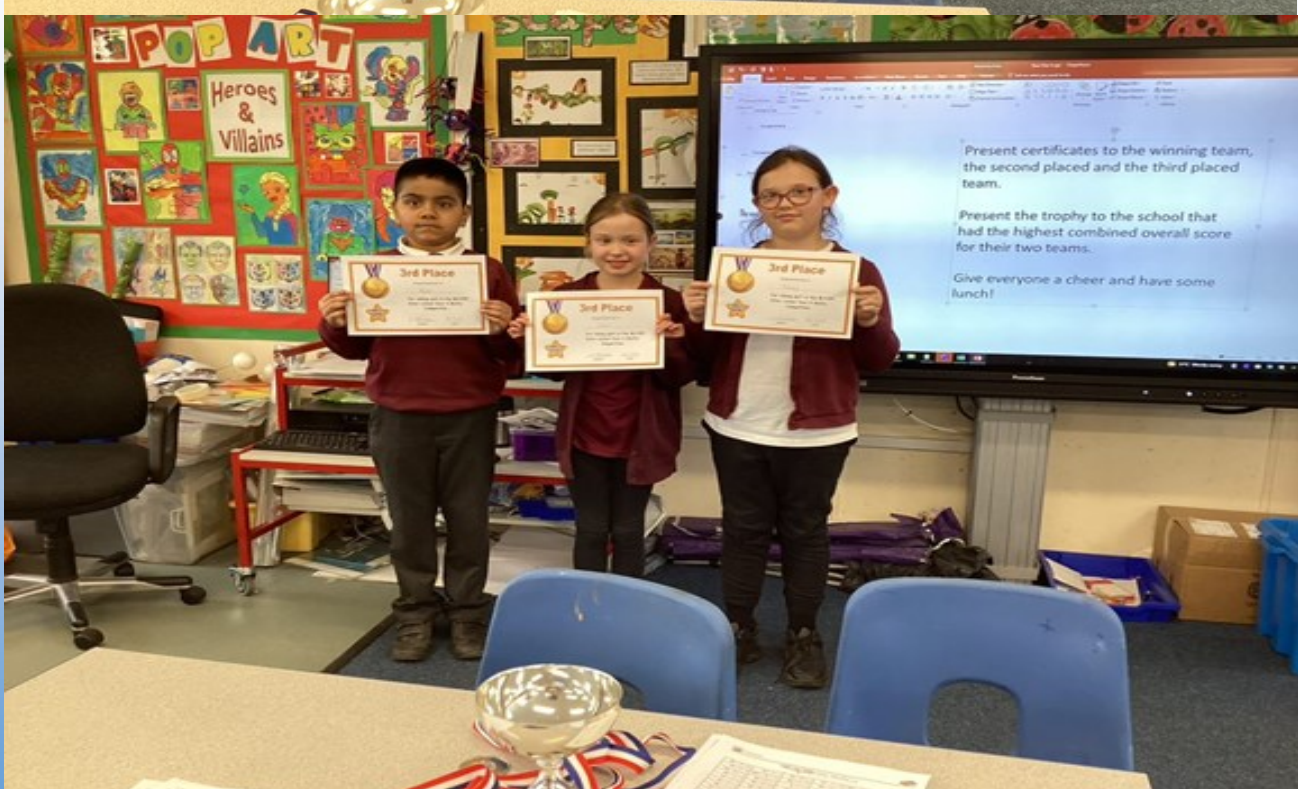
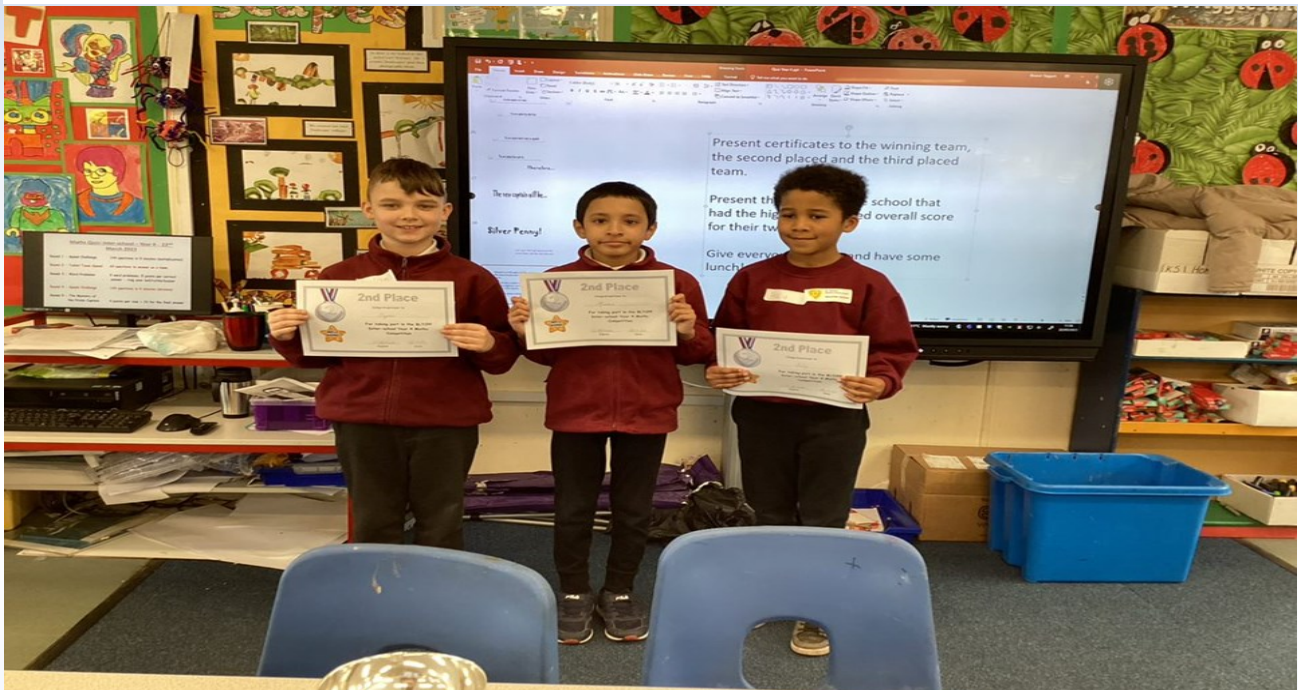
LTCPP Y4 Maths Competition

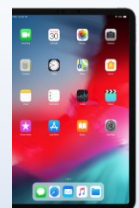

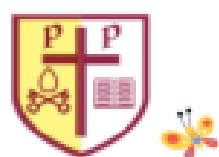
