MESSAGE FROM HEADTEACHER

Dear Parents/ Carers,

Thank you to all those who joined us for our successful sports day. It was lovely to see so many of you and the children were lifted with the support. All of the children did so well and their determination and success was wonderful to witness.

I apologise about my mix up with dates and I can confirm that SS Peter and Paul feast day is this Thursday (29th June)- children can come in red or blue clothing and we have Mass at 10am. (at least it shows that some of you read the newsletter!)

On Friday the children in Y1 and Y4 will receive letters about class allocation next year. Please be assured that every thought has gone into this placement. 

Dear Parents,

I am pleased to inform you that following the outstanding success of the previous 30 years coaching courses, we are organising the 2023 Summer Soccer Fun Week.

The children will be coached by F.A. COACHES and EX-PROFESSIONAL PLAYERS. Coaches are DBS checked and safeguarding trained. The coaches will develop self-confidence and self esteem through encouragement and positive reinforcements. SOCCER IS NOT JUST FOR THE STAR PLAYERS!

The course is tightly structured with the players fully supervised at all times. All children are catered for from the absolute beginner to the more experienced players. Players are grouped together according to age, ability and experience.
