Dear Parents/Carers,

Thank you to all the families that joined us for Family Mass on Sunday. The children who volunteered to read did so beautifully. We have started the season of Advent—where we prepare for Jesus to come at Christmas. The staff all wore purple on Monday and the class prayer spaces changed to purple, the colour of Advent. The children are very knowledgeable about the Advent and showed this in assembly on Monday morning.
