## MESSAGE FROM HEADTEACHER

Dear Parents / Carers,

Welcome back to our final half term of this academic year. This term is packed with different events and I have listed some of them in the newsletter for you.

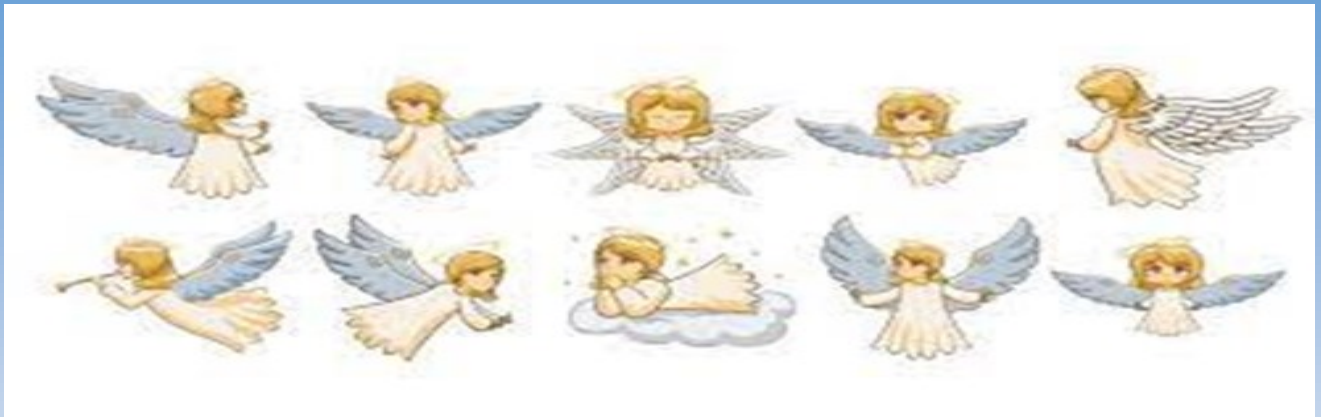

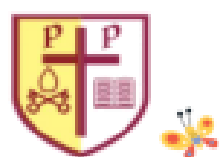
