Dear Parents/ Carers,

Our Y4/5 and Y5/6 are off to the space centre today for out of this world adventures. We hope they have an amazing day.

Thank you to all the parents who have joined us over the last week for INSPIRE workshops. It has been a pleasure to welcome you in to work with your children on various topics they are studying in school. I hear some of you were quite the experts in sewing activities.

I have been keeping you informed about attendance over the last few terms and I am pleased to report we are nearly at our whole school target of 95% attendance. Currently we are 94%. I really appreciate the support our families show by trying to get children into school everyday. 95% attendance still means two weeks of school missed across the year. When attendance falls to 90% it means six weeks of missed school—equivalent to a half term of learning. We as a school do everything we can to support your child's learning and progress. Please do kept ensuring good attendance and help us to support your child well.

We are not in school for Ash Wednesday this year. Masses are on at both SS Peter and Paul and Holy Cross church. I will forward the parish newsletter so you are aware of timings.

We thank Dan and Emily from One Life music for leading our whole school retreat day. The children enjoyed their time with Dan and Emily and were excellent with their singing and signing. We will be able to use the songs they have learnt in our assemblies over the coming weeks.

May I wish all of our families a very happy half term. We look forward to welcoming the children back for the second half of our spring term on the 19th February.
