Dear Parents/ Carers,

Yesterday, new guidelines were issued in regards to the control of Coronavirus. I would like to assure you that we are taking all measures to reduce the risk of a spread of infection in our school.

We are ensuring children and staff follow good hygiene procedures such as regular handwashing through the day, especially before eating and after using the toilet. We also follow the catch it, bin it, kill it, routine when sneezing/ coughing. Children and adults are also encouraged to wash their hands after sneezing too. Each class has anti- bacterial wipes and gloves to wipe surfaces regularly.

If your child has a persistent cough or a high temperature the new guidelines state that they should self-isolate for up to seven days, (at least 48hours clear of temperature / cough). These guidelines will be adhered to in our school and this will be recorded as an authorised illness.

Please understand that the guidelines are changing regularly, and we may have to send out regular correspondence as these changes come into action. If the decision to close schools was taken by the government, we would provide work to be completed at home by the children. Please also check that your children's log in for on-line resources such as My Maths, Rockstar times tables and Spelling Shed are working, as these will form part on the home learning set. Parents would be kept informed through the school website and the texting service, please ensure all contact details are up to date.

All visitors will be asked to hand sanitise and anyone with a cough or high temperature will not be permitted to enter the premises.
