

## ***Music at SS Peter and Paul Catholic Primary School***

Children will meet the National Curriculum expectations in music, through using the Charanga Music scheme.

Children will develop self-confidence and teamwork skills through performance. They will have opportunities to sing as a class, in smaller groups and as a school community weekly during, 'Songs of Praise', and during Mass.

In Year 4/5, children will have the opportunity to learn to play a musical instrument supported by Entrust. This year they are learning to play the Ukulele. Children in Years 4, 5 and 6, children can learn to play the flute or clarinet. They will be taught by specialist Entrust teachers.

Children will listen to, review, and evaluate a range of music across a range of historical periods, genres, styles, and traditions, including contemporary music and the works of the great composers and musicians using subject specific vocabulary relating to the musical elements; rhythm, pitch, dynamics, tempo, texture, structure, and melody.

Opportunities will exist for children of all ages to experience learning beyond the classroom. This will allow them to enrich their knowledge by, for example, performing in the Young Voices Concert.
