

Nursery Admissions Policy

Mission Statement

With Jesus as our guide, we learn, pray and live together, in a safe and happy way.

The Admission Policy of the Governors of SS Peter and Paul Catholic Primary School for the 'Little Learners Nursery ' is as follows:

The ethos of this school is Catholic. The school was founded by the Catholic Church to provide education for children of Catholic families. We ask all parents applying for a place in our nursery to respect this ethos and its importance to the school community. We welcome children from all faiths to apply for a place in our nursery.

The School's Admission Number for the school year 2017/18 is 48 (15 hour placements).

The Nursery admits children throughout the school year. If at any point the number of applications exceeds the admission number, the governors will create a waiting list for places at the nursery. Admission from this list will be prioritised in accordance with the following criteria.

1. Statement of Special educational needs
2. Children who are looked after by the authority
3. Sibling of child already in attendance at school. (Note 1)
4. All Other children

Note 1

The definition of a brother or sister is:

- A brother or sister sharing the same parents;
- Half-brother or half-sister, where two children share one common parent;
- Step-brother or step-sister, where two children are related by a parent's marriage;
- Step-brother or step-sister;
- Adopted or fostered children

The children must be living permanently in the same household

If you require full time hours and school can only facilitate part- time it may be that the hours could be split over two settings. If this can be agreed with the Nursery manager and the second setting prior to taking a place in the nursery.

Please note:

Parents must apply on the LA form for a place in Reception Class. Attendance at a nursery does not automatically guarantee that a place will be offered in main school.
